Manners Classes

Whole Dog Training classes are designed to help you teach your dog manners for the "real world." All group classes are designed for dogs that are friendly around other dogs and humans.

Our "Levels" classes are based on the Karen Pryor Academy Dog Training Program bringing you the most up to date, scientific and effective training methods. Our program also allows you to begin classes right away without waiting for the next session to begin.

Good Manners Level 1: "Attention and Focus"

Good Manners Level 1 is designed to help pet parents start on the right paw with their dog. The focus of this class will be attention to you, beginning leash walking, relaxing in the presence of new dogs and people, and how to be a good leader for your dog. Minimum two weeks required in Level I before moving to Level II.

Good Manners Level 2: "Teamwork"

Level 2 is designed to help pet parents teach their dogs the life skills that every adult dog should have. Building on the skills taught in Level 1, you will focus on loose leash walking in more difficult environments, keeping your dog's attention during distractions, learning polite greetings, how to stay, and more.

Pre-registration is required for all classes to ensure small class sizes and individualized attention. You have up to 10-weeks to use your class credits, so you can choose how often you want to train with your dog. Come every week, every two weeks, or when you have time in your schedule.

Length of class: Each class is an hour long. 6 class credits are \$150, additional class credits can be purchased for \$25 per class. Most dogs get through Levels 1 and 2 with 6 credits. Any left over credits can be transferred to other classes.

Size of class: Classes are limited to 6 dogs-- Dogs must be at least 5-months-old to begin Manners Classes.

Pre-requisites:

All dogs must be friendly with other dogs and people.

Please Bring about 1 cup of your dog's favorite treats, a 6-foot leash and a mat, pad or towel for your dog to sit on during class. A copy of your dog's current vaccinations are required at Orientation. All dogs must be on a regular collar, or harness (no choke chains, pinch or electronic collars)

Puppy Classes: Foundation for Manners

Puppies 8-16 weeks will learn how to pay attention, focus on owners, and socialize to novel things, including proper play with other puppies. Puppies must have one set of vaccines with proof of vaccines. Please call to sign up or for instructions about what to bring to class.

- To relax on a mat around other dogs and people
